What to Recycle?

(These items are accepted free of charge. Must be separated based on material.)



Cardboard and Paperboard
(cereal boxes)



Glass



Aluminum and Steel Cans



Paper
(White and pastel office paper, newspaper, phone books, magazines and catalogs.)



All Plastics
(#1 - #7)



Scrap Metal



Oil/Antifreeze



Oil Filters



Batteries

How to Recycle?

- ⇒ Rinse Containers
- ⇒ Remove Lids
- ⇒ Remove Labels
- ⇒ Place Paper in Paper Bags or Boxes

Other Items Accepted:

Waste Tires: \$200.00 per ton

- Auto & Pickup Tires- \$2.50
- Large Truck- \$10.00

Tractor Tires and Quantities over 5 will be Weighed

Bulbs & Ballasts:

- Fluorescent Bulbs- \$.50
- PCB Ballasts- \$1.00
- Mercury Bulbs- \$2.00
- Vapor Bulb- \$5.00

Appliances: \$15.00 ea.

Refrigerators, Freezers, Microwaves, Televisions, Computers, Monitors, Printers, Stoves, Washers, Dry-

Waste Disposal:

- Household Garbage: \$60.00 per ton
- Construction Demolition: \$50.00 per ton
- Minimum Drop Charge: \$10.00 (less than 400 lbs.)
- Ag Plastic: \$25.00 per ton (\$60.00 if full of debris)

Other Information:

- County Businesses and Residents are welcome to obtain a Self Hauler License.
- All loads **MUST** be contained to prevent litter along roadways. All loads are subject to a **\$10.00 No-Tarp Charge** if it is deemed inadequately contained.
