

Frequently Asked Questions about the Vernon County Solid Waste and Recycling

1. What are your hours and where are you located?

Mon-Fri 7:30 am to 3:30 pm. S3705 County Road LF Viroqua, WI 54665

2. Do you take paint, stains, sealers, household chemicals?

Only on the Clean Sweep Days. The 2nd Saturday of May and September.

3. Do I have to be a resident of Vernon County to use your facility?

No, you do not.

4. Do you take tires? Do you take box springs and mattresses?

Tire Fees:

- Auto - \$3
- Pick Up - \$5
- Semi/Dump - \$15
- Tractor and more than 5 - \$275.00/ton

Mattresses are \$20 and mattress with box spring is \$30

5. Do you take debris from remodeling projects?

Yes, the disposal rate is \$120.00 a ton or 6 cents a pound. If it's under 400 lbs. then it's a minimum drop charge of \$20.00.

6. Do you take furniture?

Yes, the disposal rate is \$120.00 a ton or 6 cents a pound. If it's under 400 lbs. then it's a minimum drop charge of \$20.00.

7. Do you take shingles?

Yes, we will. Clean shingles, meaning no lumber, paper or garbage mixed in, are \$25 a ton.

8. Do you offer a shredding service for confidential papers.

No, we do not. You can contact Shred Nations Lacrosse, WI 608-618-4060

9. Do you take appliances?

Yes, we do. The appliance fee is \$15.

10. Do you take 4-foot fluorescent tubes?

Bulb Fees:

- Fluorescents - \$.50 each
- Led - \$2.50 each
- Vapor - \$5.00 each
- Ballasts - \$1.00

11. When do you take recycling?

Mon-Fri 7:30 am to 3:30 pm.

12. What kind of recyclables can I bring in?

Free of charge to you:

- plastics,
- mixed paper
- glass
- tin
- aluminum
- batteries (AA thru car)
- cardboard
- metal also
- oil
- antifreeze
- filters
- gasoline
- diesel
- transmission
- brake fluid

13. Do you take Ag Plastic?

Yes, the fee is \$120.00 a ton or 6 cents a pound. If it's under 400 lbs. then it's a minimum drop charge of \$20.00.

14. Do you take debit or credit cards?

At this time, we only accept cash or check.
