Blackhawk Park Boat Launch Information

Blackhawk Park has a public boat launch on the north end of the property. The landing has a courtesy dock, and is somewhat protected from the main current by a small wing dam just upstream.

There are parking spaces for approximately 10 vehicles and boat trailers. In the event that the county launch is busy, and the lot is full of vehicles and trailers, people wishing to launch their boat can choose to continue traveling on County Hwy. BI into the U.S. Army Corps campground and use one of their two launches for a fee.



The county boat launch has a self-registration Iron Ranger. There are registration slips and envelopes in the top compartment. Users should fill out the registration slip, keep a copy, and then deposit the daily fee into the envelope along with their completed registration slip. Seasonal passes are also available by contacting Vernon County Parks Administrator Adam Ash at (608) 637-5485, or by email adam.ash@vernoncounty.org. *Please keep in mind that Vernon County Seasonal passes are good for the County Landing only. Use of the U.S. Army Corps. boat launches require a separate fee.*

Vernon County Boat Launch Rates:

Daily pass =	\$ 4.00
Daily pass for Seniors (60 & over) =	\$ 1.00
Seasonal pass =	\$ 40.00
Seasonal pass for Seniors (60 & over) =	\$ 10.00
